MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS

- Each job in transportation, distribution and logistics contributes \$82,106 to gross product for the Tulsa 11-county area.
- Ten jobs in transportation, distribution and logistics support 4.4 jobs in resource-supplying companies.
- Throughout the Tulsa-area economy, 10 jobs in transportation, distribution and logistics support 10 additional jobs across all sectors.
- Each dollar of income by an employee in transportation, distribution and logistics supports the earning of an additional \$0.75 throughout the Tulsa area economy.
- Each dollar of production (value added) in Tulsa-area transportation, distribution and logistics supports additionally \$0.95 of gross product throughout the economy.
- One year's activity in Tulsa-area transportation, distribution and logistics supports total sales tax of \$50.4 million and total property tax of \$27.3 million.
